- ❖ As a part of G to G Agreement between Govt. of United Kingdom and Govt. of India on the developing the project 'NHS in India'- opening of 11 Indo U K Institutes of Health (IUIH) in India by Indo U K Healthcare Private Limited.
- ❖ IUIH, Amaravati is proposed to be the first of the 11 Health institutes that could be set up by Indo-UK Healthcare Pvt. Ltd and it will house the headquarters and some common facilities for all the 11 institutes to be developed across India.
- ❖ King's College Hospital is the partner for the development of IUIH, Amaravati, which will be

known as King's College Hospital- Indo UK Institute of Health (KCH-IUIH)

- ❖ King's College London is a public research university located in London, United Kingdom, and a constituent college of the Federal University of London.
- ❖ King's College was founded in 1829 by King George IV and the Duke of Wellington and received its royal charter in the same year
- ❖ The proposed IUIH Medicity project in Amaravati is of estimated project cost of Rs.1000 Crore
- ❖ IUIH Medicity project creates 10,000 jobs.
- ❖ IUIH is allotted 150 acres of land in Navuluru, Amaravati 2 Phases i.e. 50 acres in Phase-1 and another 100 acres in Phase-2 up on completion of development milestones of phase 1.

- ❖ Amaravati will benefit from UK healthcare expertise with direct links to UK and NHS organizations.
- ❖ Indian professionals working within these new hospitals will be up-skilled to deliver the highest standard of quality care.
- ❖ There will be opportunities for exchange of staff, research and innovation, driving quality on both sides.
- ❖ The Components for Phase-1 Project in 50 Acres include;
 - 1000 Bed King's College Hospital
 - 200 Student Nursing School
 - 200 Student Paramedic training school
 - NHS Oncology Unit with rehabilitation center
 - IUIH supply chain centers

- NHS stem cells - Translational research and medical center

- ❖ 1000 Bed King's College Hospital
 - The Proposed 1000 bedded hospital is a tertiary care multi-specialty hospital, which will be operated by King's college Hospital, London.
 - It includes departments like Gastro, Cardio, Ortho, Nephro, Trauma, General, Neuro, etc. The hospital will provide world-class health facilities in Amaravati.

- The Florence Nightingale Faculty of Nursing and Midwifery is an academic faculty within King's College London.
- The faculty is the world's first nursing school to be continuously connected to a fully serving hospital and medical school
