PREFACE

PROJECT BACKGROUND

AP Capital Region Development Authority is constituted for the purposes of planning, coordination, execution, supervision, financing, funding and for promoting and securing the planned development of the Capital region development area.

APCRDA Act 2014 came into force in 2014. As per the section 38 of the Act, the Authority shall, within one year of its constitution or within such time as the Authority may extend, prepare a perspective plan for the capital region.

PROJECT SCOPE AND COMMISSIONING

On 08 December 2014, the governments of Singapore and Andhra Pradesh signed a Memorandum of Understanding to collaborate on the master planning and development of the new Andhra Pradesh Capital City. The Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the Infrastructure Corporation of Andhra Pradesh and International Enterprise (IE) Singapore and witnessed by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh, Shri. Nara Chandrababu Naidu and Singapore's Second Minister for Trade and Industry of Singapore, Shri. S.Iswaran.

Accordingly, to set the planning direction and strategies for the capital region of Andhra Pradesh; APCRDA has taken the services of the Singapore Govt. in preparation of Perspective Plan for the Capital Region. AP Government is thankful to Singapore government for providing necessary help in preparation of Perspective Plan.

Perspective plan is a long term strategic plan providing the goals, policies, strategies and general programs of spatio-economic development of the capital region in line with the policies of the government, and includes plans for land use, infrastructure, transportation and socio-economic development prepared for the whole of the capital region that guide the development and is revised every 10 years.
