ORDER:-

In the letter 1st read above, the Commissioner, APCRDA has stated that in the execution of its tasks related to the development of the world-class capital city within timelines and budgets, APCRDA has to establish global benchmarks and study best practices to replicate them in its planning, development and implementation phases. APCRDA is interacting with numerous global agencies for this purpose, including the Government of Singapore, the Centre for Liveable Cities, etc. Further, more APCRDA experts are required to visit Singapore and other countries to learn / study these practices, in a short span of time and in exigent circumstances. For the above purpose, the personnel of APCRDA have to visit Singapore and other countries time and again, sometimes in short span of time in view of urgency. There are certain instances that a team of officials had to visit Singapore all of a sudden to discuss master plan issues but could not leading to certain errors in master plan which led to project delay by 2 months. Due to last minute permissions or denial of permissions, both money and time are lost. Travel tickets, accommodations, local transport which were booked in advanced have to be cancelled if the permissions are denied. If they make arrangements after receiving permissions, the cost of travel tickets etc., will be high. Time is also lost in making arrangements and cancelling the arrangements and also in coordinating with various departments in getting the permissions. The Andhra Pradesh capital construction is a special project which needs multifarious efforts. This project is prestigious project of Government and time bound project.

The consolidated guidelines issued in GO Rt No. 3611 GA (SPL.D) Dept., dt: 13.08.2015 will come in the way of achieving the targets.

2. The Commissioner, APCRDA has also stated that as per the decision taken in the Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority meeting held headed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh as Chairman, the Commissioner, APCRDA has requested the Government to delegate the powers to Executive Committee of APCRDA for permitting the employees, staff and other connected personnel of APCRDA, to visit foreign countries on official purpose within the limit of budget earmarked for foreign training and capacity building visits from the budget of APCRDA.

3. In the reference 2nd read above, the Commissioner, APCRDA has stated that the Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority (APCRDA) in its meeting headed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister & Chairman of the Authority has resolved among other things, to approve travel programme of Best Practices Bench mark visits of APCRDA personnel in three (3) teams to (11) cities from September 25th to October 8th 2015 renowned Globally for their Best Practices and that the authority has further resolved that all the foreign visits of staff of APCRDA shall be authorized by the Authority. The expenditure of the above tour programme will be met from the APCRDA funds and no foreign hospitality or financial assistance is availed.

4. After careful examination of the matter, Government hereby permit the following teams of officers of the APCRDA for the Best Practices Study foreign tour programme:-
