ORDER :-

In the reference read above, the Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority, Vijayawada has proposed to form a Technical Committee comprising of the Chief Engineers of various departments to examine the issues and suggest "way forward" in development of Amaravati Capital City with the Terms of Reference (TOR) indicated below:-

- 1. To examine the status of various works taken up as part of construction of capital city.
- To assess the structural soundness of the various structures which were halted since May 2019. The committee may take the services of reputed organizations in doing so.
- 3. To assess the extent of damage to roads, pipelines laid for sewer, water supply, power & ICT for the partly executed works.
- 4. To assess the quality of materials stacked at site.
- 5. To assess serviceability of pipes, steel and other materials at stack.
- 6. To recommend for suitable retrofitting methods, if required.
- 7. To recommend way forward on all the stalled works.
- 8. To give specific recommendations on the detailed process and methodology for starting all the stalled works.
- 9. To study and offer specific recommendations on the claims, if any made by various contracting agencies.
- 2. After careful examination, Government hereby constitute Technical Committee with following members with the Terms of Reference as indicated in Para –(1) above to proceed further on the stalled works:
 - 1. Engineer in Chief, PHMED Chairman
 - 2. Chief Engineer, R&B (Buildings)
 - 3. Chief Engineer, VMC
 - 4. Chief Engineer, APCPDCL
 - 5. Representative from Vigilance & Enforcement Dept.
 - 6. Chief Engineer, APCRDA
 - 7. Chief Engineer, ADCL

- 3. Further, the Chief Engineer, APCRDA will be the Convener of APCRDA works and the Chief Engineer, ADCL will the Convener of ADCL works. The Committee shall submit its report within a maximum period of one (1) month and consult all the stakeholders and visit the project sites before making specific recommendations on the issues.
- 4. The Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority, Vijayawada shall take necessary further action in the matter, accordingly.
