ORDER:

In the letter 1st read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh, has submitted a statutory proforma proposal seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section-2 (1) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, for Diversion of forest land of an extent of 9.59 ha (fresh forest area: 9.38 ha and Re-diversion forest area: 0.21 ha) in Compartment No.132 of Tadepalli RF, Guntur division for construction of Road connecting E13 trunk road in Amaravati Capital city to NH16 in favor of Commissioner, APCRDA, Vijayawada.

- 2. In the letter 2nd read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & HoFF, A.P., was sent to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Sub-office at Vijayawada of the Regional Office, for in-principle approval under Section-2 (1) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.
- 3. In the letter 3rd read above, the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Sub-office at Vijayawada of the Regional Office, has accorded in-principle approval under Section 2(1) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, for Diversion of forest land of an extent of 9.59 ha (fresh forest area : 9.38 ha and Rediversion forest area : 0.21 ha) in Compartment No.132 of Tadepalli RF, Guntur division for construction of Road connecting E13 trunk road in Amaravati Capital city to NH16 in favor of Commissioner, APCRDA, Vijayawada, and has requested to submit the compliance report on the conditions stipulated therein within the prescribed time for final approval.

- 4. In the letter 4th read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, A.P., has furnished a compliance report on the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval for onward submission to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Sub-office at Vijayawada of the Regional Office, for final approval for the above proposal. The same has been forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Sub-office at Vijayawada of the Regional Office, for the grant of final approval under Section 2(1) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, vide letter in the 5th read above.
- 5. In the letter 6th read above, the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Sub-office at Vijayawada of the Regional Office, has granted final approval under Section 2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, for Diversion of forest land of an extent of 9.59 ha (fresh forest area: 9.38 ha and Re-diversion forest area: 0.21 ha) in Compartment No.132 of Tadepalli RF, Guntur division for construction of Road connecting E13 trunk road in Amaravati Capital city to NH16 in favor of Commissioner, APCRDA, Vijayawada, subject to fulfilment of the conditions stipulated therein.
- 6. Government, after careful examination of the proposal, hereby accord permission to the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh, for Diversion of forest land of an extent of 9.59 ha (fresh forest area : 9.38 ha and Re-diversion forest area : 0.21 ha) in Compartment No.132 of Tadepalli RF, Guntur division for construction of Road connecting E13 trunk road in Amaravati Capital city to NH16 under Section 2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 in favor of Commissioner, APCRDA, Vijayawada subject to the following conditions:-

1. General Conditions

S.No.	conditions
1.1	Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged
1.2	No labour camp shall be established on the forest land
1.3	The User Agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels
	to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid
	any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas
1.4	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than
	that specified in the proposal
1.5	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without
	the prior approval of the Central Government
1.6	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no
	circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department
	or person without prior approval of the Central Government
1.7	No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be
	caused
1.8	Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and
	that too under strict supervision of the State Forest
	Department
1.9	The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-
	terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the
	user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
1.10	No additional or new paths will be constructed inside the forest
	area for transportation of construction materials for execution
	of the project work.

1.11	The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 9.38 ha
1.12	The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take
	necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forest in the surrounding area.
1.13	The User Agency shall submit the annual self-compliance
	report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State
	Government and Regional Office by the end of March every year.
1.14	The user agency shall comply with all the provisions of all Acts,
	Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and
	NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
1.15	The State Government shall ensure settlement of rights under
	the scheduled tribes and other Traditional forest dwellers
	(Recognition of forest rights) Acts 2006, before issue of working
	permission and diversion as case may be.
1.16	Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the
	interest of conservation, protection and development of Forest
	and Wildlife.
1.17	The User Agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as
	per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986,
	if required.
1.18	Violation of any of these conditions will amounts to violation
	Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and
	action would be taken as prescribed under the Act, Rules and Guidelines relevant.

2. Standard conditions

S.No.	conditions
2.1	Overburden shall not be dumped outside the width of the road.
	The muck generated in the earth cuttings will be disposed of at
	the designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris
	will be allowed to roll down the hill slopes.
2.2	The designing of culverts/bridges, if any, over the natural
	streams/rivers/canals should be done in such a manner that
	it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give
	rise to water-logging, and also does not hamper movement of
	wild animals
2.3	The User agency will undertake comprehensive soil
	conservation measures at the project cost in consultation with
	the State Forest Department.
2.4	The user agency will provide retaining walls, breast walls and
	drainage as per requirement to make the slope stable.

3. Specific Conditions

S.No.	Conditions
3.1	The compensatory afforestation scheme, as approved, shall be
	implemented by the State Forest Department at the project cost
	within a period of two years from the date of issue of order of
	diversion of the corresponding forest land.

3.2	The State Forest Department shall develop the left-out area
	between road proposal and AIIMS as an urban forest to prevent
	encroachment with the cost realized from the User Agency.
3.3	The number and design of underpasses/other structures in the Wildlife mitigation plan shall be as prescribed in the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide O.M.F.No.13-1/2019-PE dated 12th February 2021 on Preventive Measures on death of wild animals due to linear infrastructure / safe passage of wild animals "Eco-friendly measures to mitigate impacts of Linear Infrastructure on wild life" by Wildlife Institute of India and the same shall be approved by Chief Wildlife Warden. The cost of implementing the wildlife mitigation plan shall be met from the funds realized from User Agency.
3.4	All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).
3.5	The KML file of the forest area to be diverted and the CA area shall be uploaded on the e-green watch portal with all requisite details.
3.6	The User Agency has made payment Rs. 4,09,30,876/- towards CA, NPV and afforestation of left out area. Further, Rs. 55,00,000/- has been paid towards implementation of Wildlife Mitigation Plan. The levies paid by the UA shall be utilized for the same as per the approved plan/scheme.

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh, shall take further necessary action in the matter accordingly.
