ORDER:-

In the reference 2nd read above, the MC, AMRDA has informed that during the review meeting on AMRDA held on 13.08.2020, the Hon'ble C.M. among other things, has directed to constitute a committee under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to examine the buildings/housing units which are essentially required for the Legislative Capital and also suggest future course of action regarding other unfinished Apartment units/bungalows i.e., whether to fully execute or to explore means for reducing burden on exchequer.

2. The Metropolitan Commissioner, AMRDA has further informed that a decision may be needed in respect of Secretariat and HoD towers & Permanent High Court Building in view of the Act 28/2020 and also in respect of future course of action regarding unfinished Apartment units/bungalows. He has therefore requested the Government to expedite the process of implementation of the above directions of the Hon'ble Chief Minister.

3. Government after careful examination, hereby constitute a Committee under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government with the following Members to examine the buildings/housing units which are essentially required for the Legislative Capital and also suggest future course of action regarding unfinished Apartment units/bungalows/other essential buildings for the Legislative capital i.e., whether to fully execute or to explore the means for reducing burden on exchequer:-
