#### **Background:**

1. Detailed Master plan for the Captial City Amaravati was notified vide Guntur District Gazette extraordinary dt: 18, 23.02.2016.

- 2. Environmental Clearence was issued by GOI for Amaravati Greenfield capital city vide No. SEIAA/AP/GTN-151/2015 dt: 09.10.2015 with certain conditions and the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) vide Hon'ble NGT directions in the capital city matter dt. 17.11.2017 issued additional conditions and is monitoring the EC compliance.
- 3. Adoption of the same is to be done in the Zoning Regulations of the Capital city, accordingly commissioner, APCRDA has issued proceedings vide: MAU61-EE0ENV(OTH)/2/2020-CZLE dt:15/02/2025.

#### **Justification:**

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), as part of its Environmental Clearance process, mandates specific conditions to prevent, control, and reduce environmental harm, particularly during the construction and operational phases. These are framed in accordance with the **Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**, and associated notifications like **EIA Notification, 2006 and** aligned with best practices in sustainable management.

Construction activities are inherently associated with environmental disturbances, particularly air and noise pollution. During the development of large-scale greenfield capital cities like Amaravati, the scale and duration of construction intensify these effects, impacting not only the construction workers but also nearby residential settlements, ecosystems,

and the overall urban air quality. As such, mitigation measures are not merely advisable but imperative under national and international environmental standards.

## **Proposed Amendments:**

Amendments to the ZR in this regard as follows:

All building having a minimum discharge of 15,000 liters and above per day or premises consisting of 25 dwelling units and above shall incorporate waste water recycling system. The recycled water should be used for horticultural purposes and flushing purposesA certificate in this regard shall be submitted by the Empanelled Certified expert.

**Condition 8 of EC -** Add to Rule 606 (2): Compliance

Proponent shall encourage low flow efficient plumbing fixtures, sensors, auto valves, pressure reducina devices including for toilets, faucet aerators and shower heads to conserve the water. shall Proponent incorporate these quidelines in the Byelaws.

with NBC and AP Building Rules

Rule 606 (2) may be read as follows "2. The building requirements and standards not covered in these regulations shall be governed by Andhra Pradesh Building Rules, 2017 and are to be complied with National Building Code."

"3. The developer shall install plumbing flow efficient Low fixtures. sensors, pressure reducers in wash basin taps, bath and other faucets, shower heads etc." Certificate in this regard shall be submitted b<u>v</u> Empanelled certified expert.

## Air Energy

Condition 11 of EC -The Proponent shall ensure that DG sets shall comply with noise and emission norms prescribed by MoEF CC & in Environment (Protection) Rules.

Rule 606: Adherence to MoEFCC norms under EP Rules

Incorporation Rule 606.10 may be read as follows "DG sets installed shall comply with noise and emission norms prescribed by MoEF & CC in Environment (Protection) Rules" DG sets approved by authorised agencies of Gol shall be submitted while applying for OC.

#### Condition 13 of EC -

Proponent shall ensure installation of solar panels by buildings by allocating at-least 1/3 of roof top for this purpose. This addition in to solar installation of Proponent heaters. incorporate shall these guidelines in

Rule 606: Adherence to MoEFCC norms under EP Rules

Incorporation Rule 606.11 may be read as follows "The developer shall Install solar panels allocating at-least 1/3 of roof top of the buildings in addition to installation of solar heaters" mandatory for Buildings all except for Individual Residential Buildings less than 300 Sq.mts

#### Bye-laws

Condition 14 of EC -The proponent shall incorporate energy guidelines efficiency (Energy Conservation Building Code). All the Capital complexes, Commercial. institutional and major residential complexes should be constructed following Green Building concepts and ensure energy efficiency, low carbon foot-print, resources conservation etc. The Proponent shall ensure that all the bulk consumers of the energy, shall meet a greater part of their demand through energies renewable and avoid use of fossil fuels; The proponent incorporate shall these in Bye-laws.

Amendment proposed in rule 606(1)

And is read as follows "The development permit applications in CC and AGC area comply the IGBC/ECBC/GRIHA/EDGE which achieving helps in Energy efficiency, optimum utilization of resources and promotes sustainable renewable energy. A certificate in this regard shall be submitted to the authority from the certified expert at the time of approval of Building permission."

#### Solid Waste

Condition 20 of EC The proponent shall ensure usage of fly leveling ash for reclamation of low lying areas, road embankments, for raising platforms in inundated areas, and usage of fly ash based products for construction purpose

Rule 606: mpliance with MoEF fly ash notifications

Incorporation Rule 606.12 may be read as follows

The developers shall use fly ash for levelling / reclamation of low lying areas, road embankments, for raising platforms in inundated areas, or fly ash based products including fly ash bricks, PPC MAU61-DPOAMRV(OTH)/39/2025-DP

including fly ash bricks, PPC cement, Concrete etc., in compliance with Flv Ash Notification issued by the MoEF under Environment (Protection) Act. The proponent shall incorporate usage of fly ash by construction agencies in the Bye-Laws.
